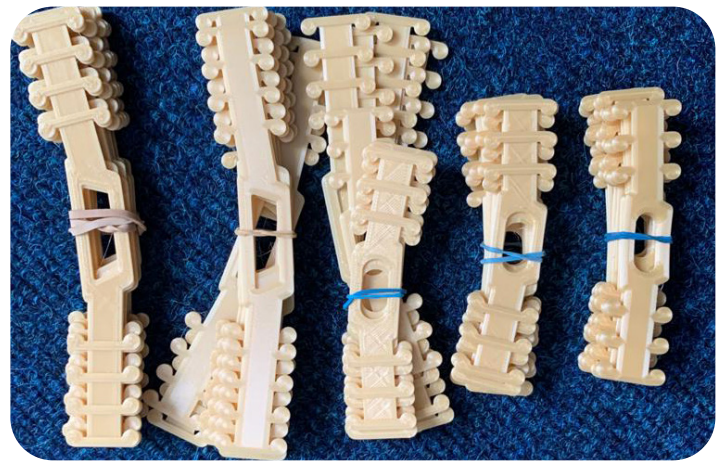




## Ear Savers Donation

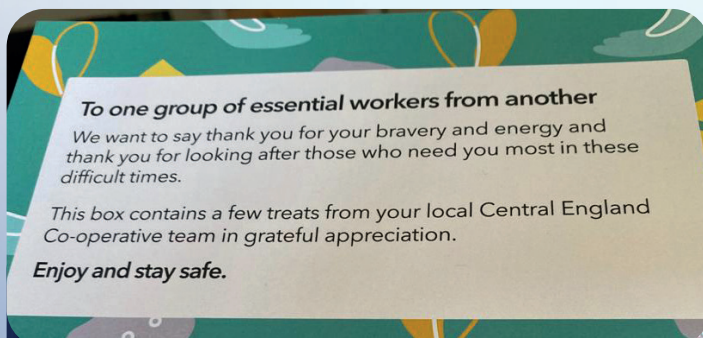


## Key Worker Badges
