Hi! My name is Casey Stocks, and I have recently become a qualified Team Leader.



We have a good training matrix here at CET. All training, induction and shadowing are provided. If there is anything you would like to know more about, our trainer will always help.

I'd say my carer super-power is helping individuals to become independent. By helping them gain confidence in themselves, they then build confidence in their independent living skills. I am also patient and understanding.

Care doesn't come without its challenges, but it is possibly one of the most rewarding jobs. The feeling you get knowing you have helped someone, even in the slightest way, is indescribable.


